Dear Parents and Community Members:

This email is written to inform you of changes in Enrollment Monitoring Committee (EMC) member's terms. As you may be aware, the EMC is a committee comprised of primarily community representatives. This committee is specifically charged with reviewing current enrollment and demographic data on an annual, on-going basis. As required, the EMC will recommend changes or new school attendance boundaries, consistent with the Board of Education's direction.

On May 6, 2008, Joe Ruffolo and Sandra Ficke-Bradford, co-chairs of the EMC made a presentation to the Board of Education entitled *CUSD 220 Board of Education Presentation – EMC Term Proposal*. The presentation discussed proposed changes in the term of a member of the EMC. On May 20, 2008, the Board of Education approved a recommendation to amend the charge of the Enrollment Monitoring Committee and change a member's term from two years to three years. The change will provide for more consistency in representation for each elementary attendance area. Finally, we also want to inform you of an EMC member vacancy at **Barbara Rose School, Grove Avenue School and Sunny Hill School**. The EMC is looking for a community representative from each of these respective attendance areas. The deadline for submitting applications is **October 6, 2008**. All applications should be mailed to your respective school and marked to the attention of the principal.
