Elementary 2012 Summer School Program

Barrington District 220 offers a self-funded Elementary Summer School Program. This program is open to any public, private or parochial student who is a resident in District 220. Students who live outside the district boundaries are also able to take summer school classes if space is available. There is an additional fee for out of district students. **This year Summer School will be held at Roslyn Road School, 224 Roslyn Rd, Barrington.**

Registration Information:

Summer school offerings can be viewed on-line starting March 19 by visiting www.barrington220.org/grove and clicking on the summer school link. Registration will begin on Monday, April 2, 2012. The easiest way to register is on-line (You will need your Home Access Information). You may also register by printing a registration form off the summer school link or by picking up a summer school flyer at Grove or any of the other District 220 elementary schools beginning on April 2. **Registration forms including the health card should be returned to Grove Avenue School, 900 S Grove Ave., Barrington, IL 60010.** Please mark your envelope "Attention – Summer School". Deadline for registration is Friday, June 8, 2012. **NOTE: Registration is first come, first serve – some courses have limited enrollment. Registration forms for out of district students will not be accepted until Friday, June 8.**

Summer School Dates:

Elementary Summer School will be held every day from Monday, June 11 through Friday, July 6, 2012. There will be **NO SCHOOL on Wednesday, July 4.**

Summer School Tuition:

See the registration form for course fees. Fees may be paid with a credit card (on-line registration ONLY) or a check payable to CUSD 220. Full payment must be made upon registration – partial payment is not accepted. Students eligible for the free/reduced lunch program may have their tuition fees waived. **Out of district students will need to pay an additional fee of \$50 per class.** Half of the tuition is refundable up until the time classes begin on Monday, June 11 if a student withdraws from summer school.

Class Times:

See the registration form for specific course times. Two hour courses run from 8:00 - 10:00 AM OR 10:00 AM – 12:00 PM. Four hour classes are 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM. Special Education Extended Programs run from 9:00 – 11:30 AM. Children should arrive for class no earlier than 10 minutes before starting time.

Transportation:

Parents are responsible for transportation to and from summer school. For students enrolled in Camp KEEP at Barrington Park District, there will be busing to camp after summer school classes ending at 12:00 PM. Transportation will be provided **ONLY** for eligible special education students of District 220.

Health/Medical Information:

The Health Office requires parents to complete the emergency information form found in the registration packet. Forms are also available on-line. These need to be sent to **Grove Avenue School before summer school begins.** If your child did not attend a District 220 school during the 2011/12 school year, a recent physical form with proof of immunizations must also be provided at the time of registration.

Confirmations:

Registration confirmation with a link to our welcome letter and drop-off pick-up information will be sent via e-mail beginning the last week of April. **For tax purposes, please keep a copy of your canceled check or credit card payment confirmation as proof of your child's attendance.**

Changing Classes:

Contact the Grove Office at 847-381-1888 if you need to change your child's class(es). We will try to accommodate your request if space is available. The Summer School Office will be at Roslyn Road School beginning on Monday, June 11. Roslyn's phone number is 847-381-4148.

Class Cancellations:

The district reserves the right to cancel any courses which do not meet the enrollment requirements. You will be notified if a class is cancelled.

Supplies:

Teachers will let the students know of any items needed for their particular course on the first day of class. Children may also bring a healthy snack each day. Water bottles are strongly encouraged.

Absences:

We encourage students to attend summer school every day to get the most out of the program. However if your child will be missing a day of summer school it is not necessary to notify the school.
