Background

- ARP ESSER (or ESSER III) is authorized under Section 2001 of the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act.
- These funds are to help safely reopen and sustain the safe operation of schools and address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on the nation's students.
- The \$6M in allocated funds may be used for expenses from March 13, 2020 through September 30, 2023.
- Not less than 20 percent of the ARP ESSER allocation is to be used to address learning loss through the implementation of evidence-based interventions and ensure that those interventions respond to students' social, emotional, and academic needs.
- Each grant recipient is to seek public comment on its plan for the safe return to in-person instruction, and subsequently post its plan on its website.

- Barrington CUSD 220 will fully return to school with in person instruction for the 2021-22 school year.
- Additional staffing, materials, and SEL supports will be provided for students.
