Once again, it's time to get ready for Barrington High School's Homecoming Parade! We want to make this a parade to remember! We are strongly encouraging the entire community to get involved by designing and decorating a float to be in this year's parade. Our theme is "Candyland Homecoming—It's Going to Be Sweet!" so think of some fun, unique ways of creating your float to help incorporate the theme. Remember to show your pride in Barrington!

The parade will begin promptly at 10:15 a.m. on Saturday, October 5. We will all meet in the commuter lot at the Barrington train station in downtown Barrington. The parade will follow the traditional route from past years from Wool Street to Main Street, and west on Main Street toward BHS. If you have a float, please be at the commuter lot at 9:00 a.m. There will be no cars allowed in the parking lot that are not in the parade. When arriving the day of the parade, you will be designated a waiting area for your group and float (if applicable).

To participate in the parade, you must turn in your attached parade application to Mrs. Concha or Mrs. Nardiello at Barrington High School by Friday, September 27, 2019.

Homecoming Float and Vehicle Rules

1. Your application must be turned in by Friday, September 27, 2019, to Mrs. Concha or Mrs. Nardiello.
2. To avoid low wires on the parade route, floats may be no higher than 14 feet.
3. Students may occupy wagons, trucks, etc. **ONLY IF THE VEHICLE HAS SIDES**
4. If you are using a vehicle, please notify us of the make and name of the car on the application.
5. Throwing candy or other items from the float or vehicle **IS NOT ALLOWED**. You may, however, walk alongside the float or vehicle and hand out candy. **ANY GROUP NOT FOLLOWING THIS RULE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PARADE NEXT YEAR.**
6. **THE HOMECOMING COMMITTEE, ITS ADVISORS, AND THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY FLOATS OR VEHICLES FOR AN INFRACTION OF THE ABOVE RULES. IF VANDALISM OR DESTRUCTION OF ANY FLOAT OR VEHICLE TAKES PLACE, SEVERE DISCIPLINARY ACTION WILL RESULT, INCLUDING THE ENDING OF CONSTRUCTION OF ONE OR MORE FLOATS.**
7. Children may only be picked up in the west parking lot of Barrington High School. The parking lot is located on Hart Road.
8. **NO LATEX BALLOONS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARADE.**

Rules for BHS Class Board Floats

1. Class Board sponsors must be present at the construction sites when building of the floats takes place. They will notify members of construction times.
2. Commercial products may be used to build the float; however, there is a \$500 spending limit.
3. All the floats must be in the commuter parking lot no later than **9:00 a.m.** This is earlier than the other entries, so be on time to avoid any confusion.
4. Floats will be judged between **9:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.** The criteria for the judging will be based on originality, suitability to theme, demonstration of school spirit, and overall appearance.
