We want to make sure that you know how to access support for your student at any time throughout the year. Being in a remote or hybrid setting makes it more difficult for some students to access support on their own. It may also be more challenging for staff to recognize when students are in need of help in the distance learning format. We need to work together to make sure that our students know that we are available to help them and want to support them whether we are in person or in remote locations.

We want to remind you and your student that it is important to connect with a trusted adult when they need to talk to someone about themselves or a friend. Trusted adults who are available at Roslyn Road Elementary School include:

- Student Services Team Members: Social Workers or School Psychologists
- A School Administrator
- A School Nurse
- Teachers, Coaches, Club/Activity Sponsors

If a student is concerned about their own safety or the safety of someone they know, we instruct them to follow one of these steps:

- Tell a trusted adult immediately
- Tell a Social Worker, School Psychologist, or School Administrator
