- The April 10, 2018 meeting minutes were presented. Adriana Rahfaldt made a motion to approve the April 10, 2018 meeting minutes. Jen Shimp seconded the motion. All voted in favor and the April 10, 2018 minutes were approved.

#### **Treasurer's Report – Adriana Rahfaldt:**

- Concession... The Orchesis dance concert generated \$640 in concessions sales.
- Individual Sponsorships...Fanograms for the April show generated \$1,265,
- There are still 5 fanograms that have not been paid for (Brown, Larkin, McHugh, Myren and Christensen).
- All fanograms for the fall show and the musical have been paid. This year's total as of April 30 is \$3,655 and that has been forwarded to the BHS fine arts department.
- Business Sponsorship...One more business sponsorship was collected in April.
- This year's total for business sponsorships collected was \$3,150. This amount was forwarded to the BHS fine arts department.

- Grants...We paid for the last 3 BHS grant requests that were submitted to us. A Masterclass online class subscription and two guest artists for workshops for the choir department...The Thundertones Men's Glee club and David Brunner.
- The FA Board had approved \$23,225 in Grants and \$22,263.43 were submitted by school personnel and paid. [See 2017 Grants Requested Analysis.](#)
- Lesson Stipends...We paid for 6 Summer Stipends at \$100 each.
- FA Student Board...We paid for the Funfair Supplies and Food for the volunteers of \$490.
