#### **Public Comment**

#### **Approval of Facilities Committee Minutes**

The Facilities Committee approved the minutes from the May 3, 2016 meeting.

#### **21<sup>st</sup> Century Classroom**

The 21<sup>st</sup> century classroom at Hough was discussed. Tim Neubauer and Tom Campagna reviewed the estimated project cost which is approximately \$85,000. The opportunity to do this project at the time of the renovation was reviewed. This project was not initially included in the Hough renovations so as to keep the projects separate.

#### **Flint Creek/Dreamway Project**

Dr. Brian Harris presented the Flint Creek/Dreamway project. This project would be a joint venture between District 220, the Village of Barrington, and the Barrington Park District. A federal grant is being sought and would provide 60% of the funding for this project. The project is contingent upon the approval of the grant. The District's portion of the cost is estimated to be between \$70,000 and \$80,000. If approved, this will be added to the 17-18 project list.
