

Teachers Classroom Checklist for Head Lice

___1. Remind students to keep coats from touching and hats, gloves, scarves etc. should be in sleeve of coat or in backpack while in cubbies/lockers. Do not allow students to pile coats in the school setting.

___2. Stuffed animals and pillows (fabric items that cannot be washed) must be bagged until school nurse gives the OK. (Dependent on cases in classroom)

___3. Items that can be washed (blankets etc.) should be washed in hot water and kept out of classroom for two weeks.

___4. Remind students to keep heads from touching.

___5. Carpets will be vacuumed daily. Minimize carpet instruction time.

___6. Reinforce social distance and remind students not to play with each other's hair, share brushes, hair items etc.

___7. During end of day specials, make sure students are keeping coats separated and not piling them on top of each other.

___8. Students with known infestations will be checked by the school nurse until they are no longer infested.

___9. Other interventions will be implemented as necessary.
