| Cafeteria | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep your hands/feet to yourself • Eat your own food appropriately • Talk quietly with kind words • Follow staff directions | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean up your area • Stay in your seat until dismissed • Quiet lunch buckets on stairs | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enter and exit in a single file line • Walk on right to be polite • Stay seated at your table until dismissed • Be sensitive to classmates' allergies • Report spills | If you follow expectations feel proud of |
| Restroom | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use quiet voices • Respect other people's privacy • Don't focus on others, worry about yourself • After use, FLUSH, wash your hands, and throw trash in the garbage | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get permission, sign out, or use the pass • Do your business and then return back to class | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave stall door unlocked after use • Do not climb or hang on the stall doors • Report problems | If you follow expectations feel proud of |

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| Playground | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play by the rules (all students playing must agree) • Include everyone • Take turns • Share all equipment and space • Use peaceful words to solve conflicts • Listen to and respond appropriately to ALL adult supervisors | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pick up personal belongings (coats, hats, balls, etc.) • Take responsibility for your actions—apologize when needed! • Always show good sportsmanship! • When the whistle blows, line up <u>immediately</u> in a single file line • Take care of equipment and put away after use • Hold equipment in your hands when in line | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use all equipment appropriately (for example: only slide DOWN the slide, only crawl INSIDE the tunnel, etc.) • Stay on playground, black top, or field areas in view of adults • Keep hands and feet to yourself • Dress for the weather • Report problems | If you follow expectations, you will feel proud of your actions. |
| Bus | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use appropriate and kind words • Talk only to students seated next to you • Use quiet voices • Listen to and respond appropriately to the bus driver | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pick up after yourself • Keep your belongings in your seat • Bring only appropriate items to school • Keep valuable items at home • Keep electronic devices in your bag | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay seated • Face and body forward • Silence at train track crossings • Keep hands and feet to yourself • Keep food in your bag | If you follow expectations, you will feel proud of your actions. |
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| Technology | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use respectful language and polite manners when communicating online. • Stand up to others who are cyberbullying or tell a trusted adult. • Return laptops (and other equipment) to the correct location and make sure everything is charged and ready for the next student. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand and follow the Acceptable Use Policy (on the OK screen when you log in). • Keep personal information, including your password and pictures private. • Report and avoid inappropriate resources and communication that might be confusing or make you feel uncomfortable. • Keep personal electronic devices silenced and in your locker or backpack. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move and use equipment respectfully, responsibly, and carefully. • Shut down laptops properly (without using the power button). • Report computer damage and problems to a teacher as soon as possible. • Navigate only to teacher-approved learning sites. • Only share information, pictures and messages that are appropriate (Remember, even deleted information can be viewed). | <p>If you follow expectations, you will feel proud of your work.</p> |
