Non-Barrington 220/Out of District Students:

Non-Barrington 220 Students, enrolled in a Barrington 220 school for the Fall:

Once the student is enrolled for the following school year, the student may register for summer school. On-line registration will be available within 24 hours of registration.

Non-Barrington 220 Students Living in District 220 Boundaries, NOT Attending a Barrington 220 school in the Fall:

Students are eligible to take classes. Registration will be from May 9-June 2. After June 2 a \$25.00 late fee will be assessed. Please come to the BHS Counseling Office, by appointment only 847-842-3296, to register. The following must be submitted at the time of registration in order to confirm the seat in the course:

1. Summer School Enrollment Form (available in counseling office only)
2. Registration Form Completed (available in counseling office only)
3. Full Payment at time of registration by check
4. District Health Form (available in counseling office only)
5. Immunization Record
6. Recent Physical
7. 3 Proofs of Residency

Non-Barrington 220 Student NOT Living in District 220 Boundaries:

Students are eligible to take classes with Summer School Principal Permission. Registration will be from May 30-June 2. Please come to the BHS Counseling Office, by appointment only 847-842-3296, to register. The following must be submit at the time of registration in order to confirm the seat in the course:

1. Summer School Enrollment Form (available in counseling office only)
2. Registration Form Completed (available in counseling office only)
3. Full Payment at time of registration by check
4. **An additional, one time out of district fee of \$50, needs to be included with the payment.**
5. District Health Form (available in counseling office only)
6. Immunization Record
7. Recent Physical

Extended School Year Information

SPECIAL EDUCATION

When: ESY

Where:

Barbara Rose Elementary, Roslyn Road Elementary, Prairie Middle School Campus, ELC, and Barrington High School.

Registration:

Registration will take place at each student's Annual Review.

Tuition:

Students must be identified as eligible for Extended School Year (ESY) Summer School at the Individual Education Program (IEP) Conference/Annual Review. Requests for related services will be considered at the Annual Review. There is no cost to parents for the Extended School Year Summer School.

Transportation:

Transportation will be provided only for eligible special education students of CUSD 220.

FAQ

Does the district provide transportation?

Parents/students are responsible for transportation to and from school. Transportation will be provided for qualified participants.

What determines if a class will be cancelled?

You will be notified if a class is cancelled. It is important to have an alternative plan if a class is cancelled. The district reserves the right to cancel any courses which do not meet enrollment requirements or if unable to secure a certified instructor.

Who do I pay lab/equipment fees?

If your course or camp requires a lab or equipment fee, you will pay the fee at the time of registration. The lab/equipment fee is non-refundable after May 8th.

Health Information

What do I need to provide the nurse's office?

Students entering grades 6-8 that were enrolled in a District 220 school during 2016/17 have records on file. Teachers have access to students' health conditions and emergency health plans. Please update the summer school nurse if there are any changes. School Board Policy 7:100 requires the most recent physical and immunization record must be on file.

If a student was not enrolled in a District 220 school, they will need to fill out an Emergency Health Form. Please notify the nurse if your child has an Emergency or Health Plan in place at his/her present school. If you are not enrolled at CUSD 220 you must submit a health form, immunization record and recent physical with your registration.

Nurse Notes:

Does your child have Asthma, Food or Bee Allergy, or other Health Conditions?

- Please remember that if your child has an Inhaler or Epi-Pen that they carry at school, to notify the Summer School Nurse.
- Children prescribed an Inhaler or Epi-Pen should have them available during summer school in case of an emergency.
- Appropriate medication forms should be on file.
- Students may need an Emergency Care Plan (ECP) developed by the school nurse to be shared with teachers and coaches that have a need to know.
- Contact the School Nurse if you have any concerns regarding your child's health status during summer school.

INTRO TO ROMAN CIVILIZATION

Open to grades 6-8

The history of Rome is immense. It spans over 1,500 hundred years, equivalent to about 6 lifetimes of the United States of America's existence. To cover all of Rome's history in depth and in one summer course is not possible, but all is not lost. This course provides a survey of a civilization that began as a village around the banks of the Tiber river in central Italy around the mid-8th century BCE, grew into the western world's largest and most powerful empire for more than a thousand years, then collapsed in the 4th century CE. To this day, however, Rome's legacy – its language, history, art, literature, and architecture – still endures and informs many facets of the modern day, from our law codes and institutions to the fine arts, and much more. This course will explore the history of one of the greatest civilizations the world has known.

FILM APPRECIATION AND CRITICISM

Open to grades 6-8

2ND Session only (10:45am-1:00pm)

This course is designed for students who have an interest in films and/or writing. The students will view animated and appropriate live action motion pictures varying in styles and intended audience. The final week of summer school, students will view films of their choosing to review and critique. In addition to viewing each film, students will analyze, criticize and discuss different aspects of the films ranging from themes, use of color, use of sound/song, acting, cinematography, etc. This course will require critical thinking, discussion, and critical writing. Films will be rated from G-PG 13.

LITERACY THROUGH SPORTS

Incoming 6th grade: 1st Session Only (8:15am-10:30am)

Incoming 7th and 8th grade: 2nd Session Only (10:45am-1:00pm)

This course will combine the participation in athletics, as well as reading and writing about a specific sport each week. The first half of the class will be spent reading and researching about a sport's history, its athletes, and its future. Student will be researching and writing a column pertaining to the selected sport by the end of each week. The second half of class will be spent playing a sport. Not only will we be working on literacy skills, but improving our fitness at the same time! Sports are not guaranteed but suggestions include baseball, softball, basketball, kickball, boot camp and fitness exercise.
