Paid Summer Jobs for Students (age 16 – 25) with Disabilities



A hand up, not a handout

We are bringing a proven program to Barrington that pairs a returning college student with a student with a disability to work together in performing a summer job that would typically employ a returning student (without a disability). Good for the employer. **Real work, real jobs**

- We hire and train a college student who serves as the student's coach/partner
- We match the team to a job an area employer is offering
 - Student will be paid by Barrington Employers
 - Job Coach/Partners will be hired and paid by Barrington-SET/ BYFS
- The coach/partner and student act as a team to perform the job with the objective of exceeding employer expectations and transferring the experience and job skills over to the student (students work 5-40 hours per week)
 - Job Coach Partners: Employed May 30 – July 23, 2017
 - Students with Disabilities: Employed June 12 – July 23, 2017

Studies show that having a summer job is the best predictor of a student with a disability being able to secure a job as an adult.
